The Bon Air Bridge Replacement Project is well underway and the City wants to keep residents and motorists informed about current construction activities and what to expect as we work toward the construction of a new, safer bridge with greater capacity and improved pedestrian and bicycle safety.

Current construction activities include ongoing bridge removal and preparation for in-creek work. Traffic controls for Phase 1B have been in place for over a month and will continue for approximately one year. Traffic controls help to ensure that motorists, bicyclist, and pedestrians continue to have safe access across the bridge throughout construction. Generally, vehicle and pedestrian traffic has been shifted to the south side of Bon Air Road to accommodate the work on the north side of the bridge.

The traffic signals at Bon Air/ Magnolia and at Bon Air/ S Eliseo have been optimized for current traffic conditions. The timing will be reevaluated with the change in traffic patterns anticipated at the beginning of the school year to accommodate increased traffic and to support Safe Routes to School. Additional delays should be expected during the first few days of traffic monitoring while the signals are adjusted.

Here are some important dates to note for upcoming project construction activity:

- **Monday, August 20, 2018 – North Trestle Construction, Bridge Foundation & Pile Driving**
Construction is scheduled to start on the North Temporary Trestle and will include demolition and pile driving (toward the end of the month). You can expect noise from pile driving operations (between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Mon-Fri) and intermittent delays at the Route 20 Bicycle Path. Trestle construction will be followed by work on the permanent bridge foundation which is expected to be completed by November 2018.
- **Wednesday, August 22, 2018 – Reopening of Signalized Pedestrian Crosswalk**
The signalized pedestrian crosswalk at Bon Air Road and Magnolia Avenue will be reopened to provide Safe Routes to School. Pedestrians are advised to cross Bon Air Road at Magnolia and the sidewalk on the south side of Bon Air Bridge is open. All other pedestrian crosswalks and sidewalks closures planned during Phase 1B will remain closed.
- **Monday August 27, 2018 – Maintenance Road Closure**
Access to the Flood Control Maintenance Road on the west side of the creek, north of the bridge, will be closed at Bon Air Road (due to the proximity of heavy equipment work in this area). The path on the east side of the creek, north of the bridge, will remain open, but will be subject to minor delays as construction equipment crosses the path to access the trestle.
