**Aerial Views of Bon Air Bridge After Completion of Stage 2 Foundation and Bent Caps**

The Bon Air Bridge Project is pleased to announce that Golden State Bridge (Prime Contractor) has completed work on the Stage 2 (south) bridge foundation piling, concrete pier columns, abutments, and bent caps. Crews are next expected to begin work to upgrade the storm drainage system at the intersection of Bon Air Road and S. Eliseo Drive. This work includes installation of new drainage inlets, manholes, and replacement of aging drainage infrastructure.

In mid-March, in preparation for the removal of the stage 2 cofferdam and upcoming placement of large precast concrete bridge girders, the traffic alignment on Bon Air Road between Bon Air Bridge and Magnolia will be shifted to the north side of the street. The next major milestone will be the placement of large precast concrete bridge girders, expected to be completed this summer. In order to place the bridge girders, the Bon Air Bridge will need to be closed for one week (similar to the bridge closure activities that happened during Stage 1 construction in the summer of 2019). The Bridge will remain open to pedestrians and cyclists. Further information, regarding the full bridge closure and detour routes, will be included in the next construction update.

Special precautionary measures are in place for construction debris containment and handling to protect Corte Madera Creek at all times. We understand that construction activities are loud, and the City's noise and work hours ordinances will be enforced. Additionally, please use caution when traveling through the work area and expect periodic lane closures to allow construction equipment to safely enter and exit the work zone.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we continue to make these important improvements.
