PLANNED ONE-WEEK BRIDGE CLOSURE AND DETOUR JULY 12 – 18, 2021

SIDEWALK TO REMAIN OPEN DURING BRIDGE CLOSURE

A Planned One-Week Closure of the Bon Air Bridge is scheduled to start on Monday morning, July 12, 2021, beginning at 5:00 a.m. The bridge is scheduled to reopen at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on Sunday July 18, 2021.

This temporary closure is the second of three planned full bridge closures for the project (the first one occurred in the summer of 2019). The closure is required to allow the Contractor to install large precast bridge girders as part of Stage 2 construction.

Road Closure and Detour

Bon Air Road will be closed from just east of the driveways for the medical offices on the west side of the bridge to South Eliseo Drive on the east side. The Detour Route is Magnolia to College to SFD. Detour signs will be in place to guide the public.

Know before you go!

- During the closure, the bridge will be completely closed to all cars, 24 hours per day for the closure dates as noted above.
- Please allow for extra travel time to utilize the detour route.
- The sidewalk will remain open to pedestrians.
- Bikes must be walked on the sidewalk.
- The bridge may be opened sooner if the work progresses ahead of schedule, and it is safe to do so.
- Please note that all dates are estimated and subject to change.
- We appreciate your patience and cooperation in following all onsite construction signage.
